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President's Message

Message from the President of the SLLA – 2021/22



As the President of the Sri Lanka Library Association (SLLA) 2021/2022 and the Chairman of the Council, I would like to share my message with you all at this remarkable occasion of the 62nd Annual General Meeting on 23rd September 2022, along with a review of the achievements during the past year. First and foremost, I would like to convey my gratitude to all the scholars and professionals who contributed in various ways to uplift the quality of the Sri Lanka Library Association according to its vision, mission and objectives.

Remembering the golden age of SLLA in 1960, Mr. Harold V. Bonny, the UNESCO experts who shared his visionary statements that had later been further validated through the activities and services of the Association. Mr. Bonny, while addressing the inaugural meeting of the

Ceylon Library Association (now SLLA) hailed the formation of the Association as a laudable act in the annals of library history of Sri Lanka. "...There are now nine librarians in Ceylon with overseas qualifications: six others are abroad on fellowships. These people have an especial duty to train their colleagues....."

It was indeed strength of the SLLA to have had overseas trained and qualified librarians who transferred their knowledge and skills to the succeeding young library professionals in the country.

"I regard the formation of your Association (Ceylon Library Association) as the greatest step forward in the history of library development in Ceylon. It is the making of a new era."

The previous governing Councils have worked in various ways to achieve the goals of the library association considering the above points mentioned in Mr. Bonny's statement, present governing Council also initiated various projects and trainings sessions to achieve professionally important matters for all members and the participants of educational programs conducted by SLLA. We consider that it is our duty to carry out these activities continuously.

On October 15, 2021, I was elected as the 28th President of SLLA. Accordingly, seven objectives were mentioned under our 2021/2022 council that we hope to achieve within a year. With those objectives, I would like to mention that the book related to all the legal affairs of the Library Association is being compiled and other objectives have been fulfilled. I am very happy and excited to be able to implement our annual plan in this way even in the midst of the high epidemic situation of Covid-19 and the recent economic instability in the country.

Treasurer's Report

Message of the Treasurer of the SLLA - 2021/22



Treat it as a great privilege for me to present the Treasurer Report for the period of 2021/2022 under review.

In the last Annual General Meeting held on 2021, it was decided to change the existing auditors as external accountants for the Sri Lanka Library Association and appoint new external auditors according to the request of the General membership. Accordingly, after an extensive search, Piyawardena Associates, Chartered Accountants was selected as external auditors approved by the SLLA Council and they carried out a comprehensive external audit of SLLA for the year ended 31st March 2022 and has submitted audited financial statements for our review. Below are some key extracts from the said audited financial statement.

A 26.4% increase in income compared to the last financial year has recorded which is Rs.14.5 Million compared to that of Rs.11.5 Million in the last year. This increase is dominated by the 55.7% increase in the income from course fee and examination fee from Rs.5.95 Million is the last year to Rs.9.27 Million in the current year. However, there is a drop of 22.7% in the income from membership fees in the current years.

Further, both Direct expenses and administrative expenses have dropped by 45% and 26.9% respectively compared to their figures in the last year. These drops have accounted for a surplus of Rs.6.79 Million after tax which is more than 150% compared with last years surpluses.

In terms of association's financial position, the statements reflect fixed deposits worth Rs.53.7 Million while additional having Rs.11 Million worth cash and cash equipment's in the associations bank accounts.

Further there is a new initiation done which is named under "The president's welfare fund" during the year, which is initiated with an investment of Rs.101,000.00

During this financial year, it is noteworthy to mention that the intake of the DILIS and HDIPLIS by SLLA has brought in a substantial income which has enabled the association to record a remarkable surplus of Rs.6.79 Million.

Fixed deposit balance as at 31-03-2021 - Rs. 53,720,768.00 Interest income capitalized - Rs. 3,972,542.00 Savings account balance as at 31-03-2022 - Rs. 4,594,633.00 Current account balance as at 31-03-2022 - Rs. 6,425,577.00

The main source of income for the Sri Lanka Library Association is the financial income from the education programme (Diploma in LIS and COLA). It is not advisable to depend on this alone. Therefore, the income should be increased by conducting short term courses and workshops.

1.1 Council/Ex-Co Meetings

For the years 2021/2022 the Council of the SLLA had nine (09) regular meetings including three special meetings. Also, six (06) Executive Committee meetings were conducted. The majority of meetings conducted were of physical, hybrid and online modes.

2.0 SLLA Membership

SLLA members are of two main categories: Corporate and Non-Corporate. Corporate Members -which include Associate and Fellow members - have full membership rights including voting power. Non-corporate members do not have voting power. They can upgrade their membership to corporate members after having adequate experience in the profession. The total active membership of the SLLA is five hundred and seventy (570). SLLA introduced a membership drive on occasion of the 62nd Anniversary.

2.1 Current membership by type of membership

2.1.1 Non-Corporate Membership: The current membership is thirty-one (31).

2.1.2 Associate Membership

SLLA received one hundred and six (106) applications. Out of them, the Associateship was awarded to eighty-two (82) members for the year 2021/2022.

2.1.3 Fellowship by Achievement

Fellowship by Achievement has been awarded to five (05) Corporate members of the Association during the year 2021/2022. This brings the total number of Fellow members of SLLA to fifty-eight (58).

2.1.4 Chartered Membership

Associates and Fellows get Chartered Librarianship for a given year if their membership is active. There are three hundred and eighty-two (382) members in the current (2022) Chartered Member list.

2.1.5 Life Membership

Long-standing SLLA members can apply for the life membership of SLLA. Life Membership was newly awarded to seven (07) members for the year 2021/2022. This brings the total number of life members to two hundred and thirty-five (235).

4.0 SLLA Education Programme

Sri Lanka Library Association (SLLA) celebrates (1960-2022) 62 years of Library and Information Science (LIS) education this year. The Council has planned to conduct the Certificate Awarding Ceremony at the Annual General Meeting.

Diploma in Library and Information Science (DLIS) and the Higher Diploma in Library and Information Science (HDIPLIS) is the main professional education programs, conducted by the SLLA. New education rules were implemented. The formats and issuing procedures of Certificates and Transcripts (detailed results) were continuously implemented throughout this academic year with the additional introductions of subject codes for the respective levels.

Amidst the pandemic situation. courses were conducted in two mediums (Sinhala and Tamil) through the hybrid mode (Physical and online) as stated below. The Distance Education program (postal) was held in the Sinhala medium only for the students who were unable to attend regular lectures and course materials were provided.

4.1.12 Course on Library Automation (COLA)

Certificate Course on Library Automation (COLA) is one of the esteemed courses conducted by the Sri Lanka Library Association (SLLA) to enhance the skills of library professionals in utilizing Information Communication Technologies for the dissemination and retrieval of information.

Accordingly, the learning outcomes of the course displays as 1). Describe, explain and use the knowledge on ICT applications in a library setting, 2). Design, host, and maintain a Website for the library and 3). Install Koha ILMS and create an online catalogue. To complete the above learning outcomes, the course covers the following areas: Introduction to Information Communication Technology (ICT), Introduction to library automation, Library automation with koha integrated library management system, Electronic library resources and services, Web designing, hosting and maintenance.

After the three-year gap, the SLLA was able to start the COLA course in 2020 with the revised syllabus under the coordination of Ms R.M Nadeeka Rathnabahu, Senior Lecturer, Department of Library and Information Science, University of Kelaniya. Thereby, COLA was started on 15th February 2020 with 21 students. Initially, the classes were held at the SLLA auditorium. After that, it was also turned into an online mode due to the COVID pandemic. COLA Examination Results were released on the 3rd of March 2021. A number of 15 students were awarded at the ceremony on the 29th of December 2022.

As a next step, the inaugural Ceremony of Course on Library Automation (COLA) 2022 was held on 23rd April 2022 at the Auditorium of the Colombo Public Library. Ms R M Nadeeka Rathnabahu, COLA Course Coordinator, Council members of Sri Lanka Library Association, namely, Dr. R.D. Ananda Tissa: President, Mr. S.P.K.K.A. Liyanage: the President-Elect, Mr. K.G.S. Gunathilake: Treasurer, Ms. K.N. Samanthi: Education Officer, Ms. Varuni Gangabadaarachchi: The librarian of the Colombo public library and the students were present at this occasion. The COLA is conducting as an online course at present. Therefore, upgraded server capacity and zoom facilities are provided by SLLA.

5.1.3 Continuous Assessments Implemented.

6. Collaborations of SLLA with other Institutions and Organizations

SLLA works in partnership with other institutions for the betterment of the profession. This included representation in the Board of Management of the National Library Documentation and Services Board (NLDSB), and the National Institute of Library and Information Science (NILIS), University of Colombo. SLLA President represents the Association in the Executive Council of the Organization of Professional Associations (OPA).

6.1 Organization of Professional Associations (OPA)

The SLLA is a founding member of the Organization of Professional Associations (OPA) of Sri Lanka, which was established in 1975. The President, in addition to participation in Executive Council meetings, actively participated in the OPA Standing Committee on Education. Dr. R.D. Ananda Tissa, and Mr. S.P.K.K.A. Liyanage represented the SLLA in OPA.

6.2 Webinar on Managing Scientific Information Resources for Professional Work

The webinar on "Managing Scientific Information Resources for Professional Work" jointly organized by the OPA and Sri Lanka Library Association was held on the 29th of March 2022 from 6 p.m. onwards via Zoom. The guest speaker for this webinar was the Senior Assistant Librarian of the Technology Faculty Library of Rajarata University of Sri Lanka & Publication Officer of SLLA, Dr. S.K. Illangarathne. The webinar covered an introduction to modern information resources and their usage, freely downloadable information resources including e-books, e-journals, professional information portals from various scientific websites, and more supportive ways to retrieve scientific information from the Internet. Nearly sixty (60) participants including Doctors, Engineers, Accountants, and other professionals attended the event.

6.3 SLLA Sustainable Development Goals Action Plan 2022-2024

The collective mission of libraries is to provide access to information for all. The crucial services provide by the libraries regardless of their, location, community they serve directly link to the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Yet, on the one hand the contributions of libraries for the individual and societal progress have not recognized by other stakeholders, especially national governments and relevant authorities. On the other hand, library and information professionals themselves are not aware of their enormous support and meaningful contributions to the achievement of SDG targets. Sri Lanka is no exception.

It was identified that the projects that are carried out by libraries, especially public libraries are unique, relevant to their communities and directly contribute to achieving SDGs. However, most of these projects lack proper marketing and promotion among the respective communities. Also, the project benefits are not properly audited. Further, it was also identified the importance of making aware of the Sustainable Development Council of Sri Lanka (SDCSL), the national authority about the contributions already made by Sri Lankan libraries to the SDGs. Therefore, SLLA established SDG Committee to:

 Make librarians, especially in rural areas aware of UN 2030 agenda and improve their contributions towards SDGs. • Establish partnership with SDCSL to showcase real and meaningful contributions of libraries towards achieving SDGs and to learn how SLLA can contribute to Sri Lanka's Voluntary National Review (VNR) in 2022 which is the country report presented to United Nations by the government.

Actions:

- A very fruitful meeting was held with DG and members of the SDCSL on 16 December 2021.
 SLLA was ask to submit a plan outlining SLLA's strategies and actions towards reaching SDGs
- Soon after the meeting, SLLA-SDG committee held a meeting to discuss the way forward.
- Committee met 3 times in-person and developed a detailed Action Plan which was submitted to SDC in end February 2022
- A workshop was held in March 2022 at the Colombo Public Library for members of SLLA professional groups and committees to introduce the SLLA-SDG action plan and identify 3 actions and relevant activities that they can implement towards achieving the goals
- A draft Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was prepared on the request of SDC and submitted for SDCs perusal

Outcomes:

- SDC accepted the SLLA-SDG Action Plan
- Professional some groups, committees and libraries have started implementing actions and activities
- Most importantly SLLA's partnership and contributions of libraries have been included in the VNR 2022 presented to the United Nations in July 2022 by the government of Sri Lanka through SDC.



6.4 Conference Collaboration –Sri Lanka Technological Campus (VICLIS 2022)

As per the request made to the SLLA by Mr. Hasitha Koralage for collaboration for the Conference Coordinator - VICLIS 2022 council granted approval for collaborat at this conference as the SLLA has established a partnership with the SDG national authority and developed an action plan.

7. Reports of Regular Committees & Professional Groups

The President - SLLA presented a concept paper at the Second Council Meeting for restructuring Regular Committees and Professional Groups. The objective was to reorganize committees and groups within the framework of SLLA rules, to maintain a clear and transparent reporting structure. All Groups, Committees, and Sub-committees are finally responsible to the Council according to the proposed method. The groups, committees and sub committees have been arranged approximately according to the new structure. Annex II.

7.1 Publications Committee 2021/2022

The Publication Committee of Sri Lanka Library Association 2021/22 met four times & Editorial Board of the Sri Lanka Library Review met 2 times during the year. The main publications of the committee are SLLA Newsletter and Journal of Sri Lanka Library Review. Further to those publications, from this year the Publication Committee was responsible to prepare a SLLA Management Guideline.




7.8 Academic Libraries Group

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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE SHAREHOLDERS OF SRI LANKA LIABRARY ASSOCIATION

Opinion
