

The Human Library is designed to promote an inclusive way to challenge prejudice through social contact.

Just like in a real library, a visitor to the Human Library can choose a Book from a range of titles. The difference is that Books are people, and reading is a conversation. Social contact is known to be among the best ways to challenge prejudice, and the Human Library enables it to flourish. The Human Library provides a safe environment for people to engage in conversation within a framework of respect, and with the permission to respectfully ask questions and share experiences. 

First Sri Lankan Full Featured Public Library OPAC using KOHA Live on Web

The Pethalai Public Library, which comes under the authority of Koralaipattu Pradeshiya Sabha, has successfully installed and customized KOHA - Integrated Library Management System. The OPAC of the Library was officially launched by Mr. K. Sithriavel (Regional Asst. Commissioner of Local Government) and Mr. S.M. Shihabdeen (Secretary of Koralaipattu Pradeshiya Sabha) on 11th October 2016. The OPAC can be accessible at http://www.pplib.info.



This is the first full featured OPAC of a Public Library using Koha live on web in Sri Lankan history. Koha - Library Management System has been installed and customized by Mr. M.N. Ravikumar (Senior Assistant Librarian of Eastern University). He achieved this task with the minimum resources available in the Public Library. The project was initiated by Mr. M. Pragash (Library Assistant of Pethalai Library). In this event Mr. M.N. Ravikumar was honored by the Regional Asst. Commissioner of Local Government for his valuable service and providing continuous support to automate the library.

IN FOCUS

Colombo Public Library

Colombo public library is the pioneer public library in Sri Lanka, established in 1925 by amalgamating the "Colombo Library" & "Pettah Library" under the purview of Colombo Municipal Council. The Colombo public library operates 6 days a week, 11 hours a day and 9 service points including mobile library service. In addition is also providing other services such as study hall facilities, auditorium facilities, and act as a community gathering place.

Lending Library: The lending library has a wide selection of books on practically every subject in Sinhala, English & Tamil languages. Nearly 150,000 books are available for borrowing.

Reading Rooms: Reading rooms include the newspaper reading room & the periodical reading section. Public library subscribes to 62 newspapers and 100 periodical titles and 22 foreign magazines.

Children's Library: Colombo public library has a separate collection of books for children in all three languages. Story telling hour, literary competitions, guest lectures, study tours to important institutions have been introduced in order to encourage children for reading

Reference Library: Reference library is open to all library members & non-members. Considerable coverage of books in all fields in Sinhala, Tamil & English media are available for readers. Further there is a separate collection for school leavers, who follow professional courses. Such as CIMA collection and BIT collection etc.

Mobile library Service: The city dwellers who are unable to visit central library or any of the branch libraries are served by the mobile library service. There is another mobile library service called "The box library project" provides library facilities to the under privileged children of low income groups of slum & shanty dwellers.

Branch Libraries: The public library has grown into a library system with 11 branch libraries scattered throughout the city.

In-service Training: Public Library provides guidance & practical training in librarianship for the students of Department of Library and Information Sciences, University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka Library Association and the trainees of the National Library & Documentations Services Board.











The Literary Festival of Colombo Public Library - 2016

The Colombo Public Library organizes literary competition among the children of the main & branch libraries as an annual event. This year, the literary competition was held during the month of July. Essays, hand writing, drawing, folk song, & speech competitions were held in Sinhala and Tamil mediums for four age categories. First three places of each category were selected for awards.

Awards ceremony for the winners of the literary competition was held on 20th October 2016 at the Public Library auditorium. Dr. W. A. Abeysinghe, veteran author and the Chairman of the National Library and Documentation Services Board delivered the key note address. Certificates and prizes were distributed among 107 children who won at different competitions.
