Highlights of Execution of SLLA Strategic Plan (2016-2022)

- Preparation of Operation Manual for SLLA Office: 09 Reports have been submitted by the Special Committee in order to enhance the productivity of SLLA Office. (Convener: Mrs Harshini Dissanayake)
- Developing a Digital Archives at SLLA: Conversion of SLLA printed documents into digital files has been completed and accuracy of the digital files has been affirmed by checking the contents of each digital file against the respective printed copy. The structure of sophisticated Full text Digital Repository software has been established on DSpace Digital Library Software. Uploading of the following digital files is in progress.
 - SLLA Council Minutes 473 documents (1985 2018)
 - SLLA Executive Committee Minutes 559 documents (1963 2018)
 - SLLA Education Committee Minutes 138 documents (1982-2017)
 - SLLA Journal 'Sri Lanka Library Review' 416 Articles
 - NACLIS Proceedings 89 papers
 - Annual Reports & Audit Reports 57

On successful completion of uploading the files, a comprehensive online Full Text Digital Repository covering all publications of SLLA (official records + Other publications) equipped with refined search facilities will be made available with due restrictions for online access for the benefit of SLLA Members, other LIS professionals and researchers. (*Convener: Mrs Sunethra Perera*)

- An Index to the professional publications of main LIS educational institutions in Sri Lanka published during last 25 year period (1992-2017): The project has been nearly completed with the details of 1139 LIS professional articles including 643 in English, 416 in Sinhala and 80 in Tamil. Author Index has been compiled while Subject and Title indexes are being compiled at present. (Convener: Dr R. D. Ananda Tissa)
- Compiling a database on the subject expertise needed and available for major LIS education programmes in Sri Lanka: A survey through a questionnaire has been conducted and information on 62 LIS professionals and their subject expertise have been identified. Also the subject expertise needed for the Sri Lankan LIS educational programmes have been recognized. (Convener: Dr R. D. Ananda Tissa)
- Develop a model Prison Library at Welikada Prison: A number of significant steps have been taken to develop the model library including collection of library resources, following relevant IFLA guidelines and closely working with the authorities of the Prison department. (Convener: Mrs Padma Bandaranayaka)
- Formulation of Library Standards for Provincial Central Libraries: The second draft of the Provincial Central Library Standards has been concluded. (Convener: Mrs Wasantha Kuruppu)
- Identify the challenges face by Provincial Central Libraries at present with possible solutions: The second draft of the report has been completed. (Convener: Mrs Wasantha Kuruppu)
- Formulation of model Provincial Library Ordinance for Sri Lanka: The shortcomings of the present Provincial Library ordinances have been identified and the second draft of the model Provincial Library ordinance has been finalized.
 (Convener: Mr T. G. Padmasiri)
- Developing National Library Standards for Sri Lanka: The second draft of the National Library Standards has been completed. (Convener: Mr Upali Amarasiri)
- Guide to resources and services of Libraries of the institutions coming under the UGC: The first draft has been concluded based on the responses received for the questionnaire. (Convener: Mrs Sujeewa Ratnayake)
- Develop an Open Access Strategy for National Library of Sri Lanka: The first draft of the limited Open Access strategy for the National Library of Sri Lanka has been completed. (Convener: Mrs Iromi Wijesundara)
- Translations: Completion of translations of 2 IFLA publications for the benefit of LIS students, Librarians and others. The translations have been uploaded to the SLLA Web. (Convener: Mrs Neetha Peiris)
- Overview: Out of 22 projects commenced in phase 1 of the project in 2016/17, 16 projects have either been completed or have largely been completed. Out of 16 projects started in phase 2 in 2017/18, 7 projects have either been completed or have largely been completed.

In Focus

Library and Information Service in the Department of Labour

The Library is located in the ground floor of the southern wing of the Labour Secretariat. It is open from 8.30 am. To 4.15 pm. Daily on working days. In 1968 it was upgraded as a specialized research library and recently it has been classified as a special grade library. This is a reference library which consists of resources pertaining to subjects such as labour economics and labour laws. This library provides services to all the Department and Institutions under the Ministry of Labour and Trade Union Relations. In Year 2000 branch libraries were established at District Labour Offices under the main library. At present 37 mini libraries are functioning under the supervision of the main library.

Objectives

- * Develop further the collection of books and magazines
- * Improve library facilities and information services
- * Improve the network of branch libraries
- * Maintain data collection and data bases
- * Maintain Labour Museum
- * Sale Departmental Publications
- * Coordination activities pertaining to publication activities

Scope of the collection



The library's collection of books and periodicals cover the fields of industrial relations, labour economics, labour legislations, social security, child labour, women works, trade unions, occupational health and safety, gender, social dialogue etc. The Library also receives ILO publications and many other relevant publications through exchange basis. The reference collection include Dictionaries, Directories, Labour Laws, complete sets of Acts, Sessional Papers, New Law Reports, Sri Lanka Law Reports, Legislative Enactments in Sri Lanka, Sri Lanka Labour Gazettes, ILO Conventions, Newspaper Article Collection in relevant subjects and International periodicals in specially Industrial Relations-. New Legal Deposit Law

NLDSB and Department of National Archives (DNA) are engaged in drafting a new Legal Deposit Law for Sri Lanka replacing the present archaic legal deposit ordinances. Special Committee comprising Dr (Mrs) Nadeera Rupasinghe (DG/DNA), Mr W. Sunil (DG/NLDSB) and Mr Upali Amarasiri (former DG/NLDSB) has been working in the project over a year. The final draft is being prepared at present. A number of new features including the coverage of non-print and digital publications, sharing the legal deposit responsibilities between NLDSB and DNA, expanding the coverage and the responsibility of depositing, establishing a separate depository for non-print publications at DNA are in the new draft. The committee has closely followed the relevant UNESCO guidelines, new legal deposit legislations in a number of other countries and the relevant research literature while drafting the new act.

Workshop for Public Librarians

The National Environmental Information Centre of the Central Environmental Authority has organized a workshop on environment information for library staff of western province public libraries last December. More than 250 librarians/ officer in charge of the Urban Council & Municipal council libraries in Colombo, Kalutara & Gampaha District libraries participated in this workshop. Mrs. Chandrika Dabare, Director (Envt. Information), Mrs W. Wijesinghe, Director(Lab), Mr. P. Dissanayaka , Dirctor (Envt. Education) & Mrs. Sarojini Jayasekara, Director (Solid waste) made the presentations related to the main environmental issues and environmental Information in this workshop.03 types of the environmental poster in Sinhala, English, & Tamil languages



and environmental resource kit with eco-friendly bags were distributed among the participants on that day. The Chairman, Deputy Director Generals and the Directors of the Central Environmental Authority participated for the inaugural session of this programme.

The Sri Lanka Library Association (SLLA) is pleased to announce the 'Vijita de Silva Research Award', the annual research award for the best completed research in Library and Information Science (LIS) field in Sri Lanka. The award comprises a cash grant of Rs.50,000.00 and a certificate. In the event the award is given to two researches, each will receive Rs 25,000.00 and a certificate.

Eligibility Criteria for applying the award - Research paper/work eligible for consideration should be;

1. on Sri Lankan Library and Information Science field and carried out by LIS Professional/s or Professional/s from a related field to LIS(e.g. IT, Archival & Document Management, Education, Media etc.);

2. the research that have a positive impact on improving or modernizing the Sri Lankan LIS field;

such as, in a wider context, to cover every aspect of the LIS field in both theory and practice including introduction of new and smart services, new service delivery methods, designing smart library buildings and library furniture, new ways of using ICT in LIS sector, redesigning of library interior/Library Common for better services, improving LIS education etc.; 3. Research work that are;

- 3.1 submitted as theses or dissertations for a higher degree or for a professional qualification or text book/monograph will not be considered for the award;
- 3.2 already completely or substantially funded by some other organization is not eligible;
- 4. The research should have been completed within two years of the closing date of application.

SLLA Fellowship

According to the Sri Lanka Library Association (Incorporation) (Amendment) Act No. 7 of 2004, the Membership consist of corporate members and non-corporate members. The Corporate members consist of Fellows and Associates who shall have voting rights; The non-corporate members (persons not eligible to be corporate members) shall have no voting right.

Criterion of the SLLA Fellowship

Senior Associate members* of the Sri Lanka Library Association (SLLA) who have made a significant contribution** to the Library and Information profession of Sri Lanka are eligible to apply for Fellowship of the SLLA (FSLLA).

*Senior Associate member is defined as an Associate member of the SLLA who has continuous membership of the SLLA for more than 5 years after receiving the Associate ship from the SLLA.

**Significant contribution is measured by taking into account the member's contribution to the LIS profession of Sri Lanka in the following 4 areas;

- A. Library and Information Science (LIS) publications (print or electronic)
- B. Service rendered as a Key Officer/committee member of the SLLA
- C. Contribution to human resources development in LIS
- D. Research and innovations in LIS

An Area for which an applicant receives 5 or more marks will be considered as a Contributory Area of the applicant concerned.

Associate members with 05 or more years of continuous membership in the SLLA and gain a total of 20 marks for two or more areas will be eligible to apply for the Fellowship.
